



Operating at Level 2

At Alert Level 2, Shore Community Church activities can operate in a limited capacity if we are able to do so safely. We must maintain hygiene measures, including physical distancing, hand washing and regularly cleaning surfaces.

To achieve this the following guidelines are in place for all church activities and meetings during Level 2.

Meeting in Homes

- Church groups including Life Groups, Children and Youth Ministry groups, can meet in homes but there must be no more than 10 people (including family members anywhere in the house, regardless of age).
- Groups can meet for a maximum of two hours.
- Groups must maintain hygiene measures, including physical distancing of at least 1 metre, hand washing and regularly cleaning surfaces.
- Food and drink may be served. Communal amenities such as common plates, drink bottles etc., should be avoided.
- All groups, must completed the attached form and return this to the church office by email, or complete the online form - www.shore.org.nz/events.

Meeting at The Hub

- Church groups can meet The Hub. This includes LifeGroups, Worship Teams, Children and Youth Ministry Groups.
- Groups at the Hub must not be larger than 10 people.
- Groups can meet for a maximum of two hours.
- Groups must pre-book their meetings at the Hub. Please contact the church office (office@shore.org.nz) to book.
- All group members must sign in and out using VisTab. This is the church contact register and provides contact tracing.
- All Hub users must maintain hygiene measures, including physical distancing of at least 1 metre, hand washing and regularly cleaning surfaces. Please clean all surfaces at the conclusion of your meeting.

Play it safe

These are the most important things that you can do:

- COVID-19 is still out there. Play it safe.
- If you're sick, stay home.
- If you have symptoms of cold or flu call your doctor or Healthline and get tested.
